STATUTORY RULES. No. 19 of 1929.

Made under the Native Taxes Ordinance, 1917-1924.

The Native Taxes (Funds) Regulations, 1926 (Statutory Rules No. 13 of 1926), are further amended as follows:—

- 1. By inserting immediately after the word "Yaws," in the heading to Regulation 23 thereof, the words "and skin disease."
- 2. By inserting immediately after the word "yaws," in Regulation 23 thereof, the words "and skin disease."
- 3. By inserting in the Schedule thereto, in the line representing Item 7 under the heading NATIVE BENEFITS FUND after the word "Yaws," the words "and skin disease."
- 4. By repealing the figures "1,200" in the Schedule thereto, appearing in the line representing Item 7 under the heading NATIVE BENEFITS FUND and substituting the figures "1,400" in lieu thereof, being an amount of £200 more than formerly authorized.
