

STATUTORY RULES.

No. 19 of 1929.

Made under the *Native Taxes Ordinance*, 1917-1924.

The *Native Taxes (Funds) Regulations*, 1926 (Statutory Rules No. 13 of 1926), are further amended as follows:—

1. By inserting immediately after the word "Yaws," in the heading to Regulation 23 thereof, the words "and skin disease."
 2. By inserting immediately after the word "yaws," in Regulation 23 thereof, the words "and skin disease."
 3. By inserting in the Schedule thereto, in the line representing Item 7 under the heading NATIVE BENEFITS FUND after the word "Yaws," the words "and skin disease."
 4. By repealing the figures "1,200" in the Schedule thereto, appearing in the line representing Item 7 under the heading NATIVE BENEFITS FUND and substituting the figures "1,400" in lieu thereof, being an amount of £200 more than formerly authorized.
