No. 10 of 1922.

REGULATIONS

Made under *The Prisons Ordinance*, 1919

(No. 4 of 1919).

The *Prisons Regulations*, 1919 (Statutory Rules No. 13 of 1919) are amended by adding at the end of Regulation 205 the following new paragraph :—

“(2) The Government Secretary may by order in writing alter the hours of labour in any prison with respect to any kind of work to be performed outside the prison, and specified in the order, to hours different from those provided for above; but so that the hours of daily labour shall not thereby be increased.”
