STATUTORY RULES.

No. 1 of 1928.

Made under the Places of Public Entertainment Ordinance, 1915 (No. 5 of 1915).

1. The Public Entertainment Regulations, 1926 (Statutory Rules No. 2 of 1926), are amended by inserting after Regulation 15 the following new Regulation:—

"15A. The powers and duties conferred or imposed on the Government Secretary by these Regulations may be exercised and shall be carried out during his absence by any other person appointed by the Lieutenant-Governor for that purpose."
