

STATUTORY RULES.

No. 6 of 1920.

REGULATIONS

Made under *The Public Service Ordinance of 1907.*

(No. 2 of 1907.)

1. The Regulations entitled "Rules and Scale of Travelling Allowances Payable to Officers of the Territory and others while Travelling on Duty", made in Executive Council on 21st August, 1909, and published in the *Gazette* dated 1st September, 1909, are amended by omitting therefrom the last paragraph reading "The Chief Medical Officer and the Government Medical Officer, Samarai, are allowed Ten shillings per day, in addition to the above scale, for loss of private practice when travelling on duty."

2. A Government Medical Officer shall be entitled to an allowance of Two pounds two shillings for each post-mortem examination performed by him by the direction of a coroner.
