

STATUTORY RULES.

No. 6 of 1932.

Made under *The Public Service Ordinance of 1907.*

The *Public Service Regulations, 1926* (Statutory Rules No. 9 of 1926), are further amended as follows:—

1. By repealing the heading “Department of the Commissioner for Lands” together with the words and figures appearing under that heading in the Schedule following Regulation 7 thereof and substituting the following in lieu thereof:—
