

STATUTORY RULES.

No. 7 of 1919.

Made under *The Public Service Ordinance of 1907.*

1. Regulation No. 5, made in Executive Council on the twelfth day of August, One thousand nine hundred and eight, is repealed.

2. A Government officer is forbidden—

(1) to be the editor of a newspaper or to take any active part in the management of a newspaper ;

(2) to make any communication to a newspaper, whether by way of interview or otherwise, in which measures of the Government are discussed, or the policy of the Government criticized, or the official proceedings of Government officers questioned.

Any Government officer who offends against this regulation is liable to suspension and subsequent dismissal.
