

STATUTORY RULES.

No. 14 of 1938.

Made under *The Public Service Ordinance of 1907.*

The *Public Service Regulations, 1926* (Statutory Rules No. 9 of 1926), are further amended as follows:—

1. By inserting at the end of Sub-regulation (1) of Regulation 21 thereof the following proviso:—

“ Provided that when the nature of the work performed by a female officer seems to the Lieutenant-Governor to warrant it and she has completed not less than ten years service the Lieutenant-Governor may order that she be entitled from a date specified in the order to earn one or more of the following further amounts £325, £335, £345, £355.

Upon any such order being published in the *Gazette* the limits of the salary fixed for her office shall be deemed to have been re-classified accordingly.”
