

STATUTORY RULES. No. 1 of 1932.

Made under the Samarai Electric Light and Power Ordinance, 1926.

The Samarai Electricity Regulations, 1926 (Statutory Rules No. 1 of 1927), are amended as follows:—

- 1. By inserting immediately after paragraph (c) of Sub-regulation (1) of Regulation 2 thereof under the heading "Lighting" the following new paragraph:—
 - "(d) For all electricity used for lighting upon application by a consumer undertaking to consume not less than 225 Units per month Thirteen pounds for the first 225 Units and all in excess of 225 at the ordinary rate applicable."
- 2. These Regulations shall be deemed to have come into operation on the first day of October, One thousand nine hundred and twenty-nine.
