

STATUTORY RULES.

No. 7 of 1918.

REGULATIONS FOR CUTTING AND REMOVING MANGROVES.

MADE UNDER THE "SAGO ORDINANCE, 1908-1917."

1. Regulation No. 14 of Statutory Rules No. 12 of 1917, is cancelled, and the following Regulation is substituted therefor.

"14. Immediately after the granting of the application the applicant shall pay in advance such a proportion of one year's rent as shall be equal to the rent for the period from the date the application was granted up to the thirtieth day of June or the thirty-first day of December which ever of such days shall next follow the date on which such application was granted; and thereafter rent shall be paid in respect of the license half-yearly in advance on the first days of the months of January and July in every year during its currency."

2. After Regulation 17 of Statutory Rules No. 12 of 1917, the following new Regulations are inserted:—

"18. The following Regulation 19 shall apply to all Mangrove Licenses granted before the first day of April, 1918.

19. The periods and times in respect of and at which rent is made payable under any Mangrove License granted under the Ordinance prior to the first day of April, 1918, are altered as follows:—

Where under any such License any rent becomes payable in the year 1918 on any date after the first day of July in that year in respect of any period extending beyond the thirty-first day of December, 1918, then and in such case such rent shall be paid on the date it so becomes payable but in respect of a period commencing on the date it so becomes payable and ending on the thirty-first day of December, 1918, and the rent payable for that period shall bear the same proportion to one whole year's rent payable under the License as such period bears towards a whole year. Thereafter rent shall be paid in respect of such License half-yearly in advance on the first days of the months of January and July in every year during its currency."
