RULES OF COURT (MATRIMONIAL CAUSES) 1934.⁽¹⁾

- 1. These Rules may be cited as the Rules of Court (Matrimonial Citation. Causes) 1934.(1)
- 2. The Rules of Court of the Supreme Court of Queensland, (2) in Queensland force in Queensland on the fifth day of December, One thousand nine to apply. hundred and thirty-two and regulating the--
 - (a) practice, pleading and procedure; and
- (b) costs to be allowed and paid to solicitors in any proceeding in, or in relation to, matrimonial actions in the said Supreme Court shall, so far as they are applicable, apply to and regulate the practice, pleading and procedure and the costs to be allowed and paid to solicitors, in any proceeding under the Divorce and Matrimonial Causes Ordinance 1934.
- 3. Where, in any case there is no provision under these Rules Application which is applicable to any matter of practice, procedure or costs, any directions. party may apply to a Judge in Chambers for directions.
