

GOLD BUYERS REGULATIONS. ⁽¹⁾

- Short title.** 1. These Regulations may be cited as the *Gold Buyers Regulations*.⁽¹⁾
- Definitions.** 2.—(1.) In these Regulations, unless the contrary intention appears—
 “The Ordinance” means the *Gold Buyers Ordinance* 1931⁽²⁾ as amended from time to time.
 (2.) Any reference in these Regulations to a form shall be read as a reference to a form in the Schedule to these Regulations.
- Application for licence.** 3.—(1.) An application for a licence under the Ordinance shall be in accordance with Form A.
 (2.) The application shall be addressed to the Administrator.
- Licence.** 4. A licence issued under section 6 of the Ordinance shall be in accordance with Form B.
- Gold entry book.** 5.—(1.) A gold entry book kept under sub-section (1.) of section 8 of the Ordinance shall be in accordance with Form C.
 (2.) Before a gold entry book is used each page shall be numbered consecutively.
 (3.) The particulars to be recorded in the gold entry book by a licensee under sub-section (2.) of section 8 of the Ordinance shall be the particulars set out in Form C.
 (4.) The record made in the gold entry book under sub-section (2.) of section 8 of the Ordinance shall be signed by the person buying from, selling to, or depositing with, the licensee, gold.
 (5.) The signature required under the last preceding sub-regulation shall be witnessed by a person other than the licensee.

(1) The *Gold Buyers Regulations* (made under the *Gold Buyers Ordinance* 1931-1938) comprise the original *Gold Buyers Regulations*, as amended by the other Regulation referred to in the following Table:—

Gold Buyers Regulations.

6. A declaration under section 11 of the Ordinance shall be in accordance with Form D and shall contain the particulars set out in that form. Declaration by seller of gold.

7.—(1.) The prescribed authority for the purpose of section 18 of the Ordinance shall be the principal officer of Customs in the District in which the port or aerodrome from which the gold is to be exported or removed is situated. Export of gold.

(2.) The notice under section 18 of the Ordinance shall be in Form E and shall contain the particulars set out in that form.

8. Every licensee shall, before the 8th day of each month, post to the Secretary for Lands and Mines of the Territory a return in duplicate in accordance with Form F of the transactions recorded in the gold entry book during the month immediately preceding the month in which the return is made. Monthly return of gold bought, &c. Sub. by Regs. gazetted on 30.5.1931, r. 1.
