

THE RULES OF COURT (APPOINTMENT OF JUDGES' ASSOCIATES) 1936.⁽¹⁾

1. These Rules may be cited as "*The Rules of Court (Appointment of Judges' Associates) 1936*"⁽¹⁾ and shall come into operation on the Fourth day of May, 1936. Citation and time of commencement.

2. A Judge may by writing signed by him appoint an officer of the Registry of the Supreme Court to be and act as his Associate. Appointment of Associates.

3. An officer so appointed shall hold such appointment so long as he continues to be an officer of the Registry unless it be sooner terminated by writing signed by the Judge appointing him. Termination of appointment.
