## LOAN ORDINANCE 1926.(1)

## No. 1 of 1926.

An Ordinance to authorise the raising and appropriation of the sum of sixty-six thousand nine hundred and twenty-six pounds for certain purposes.

B<sup>E</sup> it ordained by the Governor-General of the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the New Guinea Act 1920, as follows:—

- 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Loan Ordinance 1926. (1) Short title.
- 2. The Administrator may from time to time borrow from the Power to Commonwealth of Australia moneys not exceeding in the whole the amount of Sixty-six thousand nine hundred and twenty-six pounds.
- 3. The amount borrowed shall be issued and applied only for the Purposes for which moneys expenses of borrowing and for the purposes set forth in the may be
