

PETROLEUM (PROSPECTING AND MINING) REGULATIONS. ⁽¹⁾

1. These Regulations may be cited as the *Petroleum (Prospecting and Mining) Regulations*.⁽¹⁾ Short title.
- 2.—(1.) Every application for a permit or a lease shall be addressed to the Administrator and shall be lodged in duplicate at the office of the Department of Lands, Surveys, Mines, and Forests, Rabaul. Lodging of applications for permits &c.
- (2.) Every application for a licence shall be addressed to the Administrator and shall be in duplicate and may be lodged at the office of the Warden within whose jurisdiction the land in respect of which the application is made is situated, or at the office of the Department of Lands, Surveys, Mines, and Forests, Rabaul.
3. An application for a permit, a licence, or a lease by an individual person or by an association of persons shall be in accordance with Form A in the Schedule to these Regulations. Form of application by individual or association for permit, &c.
4. An application for a permit, a licence, or a lease by a body corporate shall be in accordance with Form B in the Schedule to these Regulations. Form of application by a body corporate for permit, &c.
5. An application for an extension of the term of a permit shall be in accordance with Form C in the Schedule to these Regulations. Form of application for extension of term of permit.
6. The prescribed fee for the extension of the term of a permit shall be Two pounds per 1,000 square kilometres or part thereof. Fee for extension of term of permit.
7. Any person who knowingly makes any false statement in an application for a permit, a licence, or a lease shall be guilty of an offence. Penalty for false statement.

Penalty: One hundred pounds.
