

# CENTRAL COURT ASSESSORS REGULATIONS. <sup>(1)</sup>

1. These Regulations may be cited as the *Central Court*<sup>(2)</sup> *Assessors Regulations*.<sup>(1)</sup> Short title.

2. Where a person is appointed an assessor under the *Central Court*<sup>(2)</sup> *Assessors Ordinance 1925*<sup>(3)</sup> notice in writing of such appointment shall be served, at least twenty-four hours before the time set out in such notice, upon the person to whom it is directed, by delivering a copy thereof to him personally. Notice of appointment as assessor to be served.

3. Every notice of appointment of an assessor shall be signed by a Judge or Registrar of the Court and shall be in accordance with the form in the First Schedule to these Regulations. Form of notice.

4. Assessors shall be paid the fees and expenses specified in the Second Schedule to these Regulations. Payment of assessors.

5. Where in any civil cause pending in the Court any party applies to the Court or a Judge for the appointment of assessors at the trial he shall, at the time of making such application, pay to the Registrar of the Court a fee of Seven pounds. Court fee in civil cause.

Provided that if assessors are not appointed the Registrar shall return the said sum of Seven pounds to the party who shall have paid the same.
