

SEAMEN'S COMPENSATION ORDINANCE 1924-1925.⁽¹⁾

An Ordinance to amend the Seamen's Compensation Act 1911 of the Commonwealth of Australia in its application to the Territory of New Guinea.

BE it ordained by the Deputy of the Governor-General of the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *New Guinea Act 1920*, as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Seamen's Compensation Ordinance 1924-1925*.⁽¹⁾

2. Section seventeen of the *Seamen's Compensation Act 1911*⁽²⁾ of the Commonwealth of Australia in its application to the Territory of New Guinea is amended by omitting the word "Governor-General" and inserting in its stead the word "Administrator".⁽³⁾

3. In the application to the Territory of the *Seamen's Compensation Act 1911* any reference to a County Court shall be read as a reference to the Central Court⁽⁴⁾ of the Territory.
