UNCONTROLLED AREAS REGULATIONS. (1)

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Uncontrolled Areas Short title. Regulations. (1)
 - 2. In these Regulations, unless the contrary intention appears— Definitions.
 - "employer" includes the legal personal representative of a deceased employer;
 - "Ordinance" means the Uncontrolled Areas Ordinance 1925-1935. (2)
- 3.—(1.) Compensation payable under section 9A of the Ordinance Compensation. in the case of the death of a native shall be an amount not exceeding Sixty pounds.
- (2.) Compensation payable under section 9a of the Ordinance in the case of the wounding or injury of a native shall be an amount not exceeding the rates specified in the Schedule to these Regulations.
- (3.) The employer ordered to pay compensation under section 9A of the Ordinance shall pay the compensation—
 - (a) to the Treasurer, in any case where the order directs the distribution, or payment out, of the compensation by instalments extending over any period of time; and
 - (b) to the District Officer administering the District in which the order was made, in any other case.
- (4.) For the purposes of sub-section (5.) of section 9A of the Ordinance, the Treasurer in any case referred to in paragraph (a) of the last preceding sub-regulation, and the District Officer referred to in paragraph (b) of that sub-regulation in any other case, shall be the prescribed officer.
