

# UNCONTROLLED AREAS REGULATIONS.<sup>(1)</sup>

1. These Regulations may be cited as the *Uncontrolled Areas Regulations*.<sup>(1)</sup> Short title.

2. In these Regulations, unless the contrary intention appears— Definitions.

“employer” includes the legal personal representative of a deceased employer;

“Ordinance” means the *Uncontrolled Areas Ordinance 1925-1935*.<sup>(2)</sup>

3.—(1.) Compensation payable under section 9A of the Ordinance in the case of the death of a native shall be an amount not exceeding Sixty pounds. Compensation.

(2.) Compensation payable under section 9A of the Ordinance in the case of the wounding or injury of a native shall be an amount not exceeding the rates specified in the Schedule to these Regulations.

(3.) The employer ordered to pay compensation under section 9A of the Ordinance shall pay the compensation—

(a) to the Treasurer, in any case where the order directs the distribution, or payment out, of the compensation by instalments extending over any period of time; and

(b) to the District Officer administering the District in which the order was made, in any other case.

(4.) For the purposes of sub-section (5.) of section 9A of the Ordinance, the Treasurer in any case referred to in paragraph (a) of the last preceding sub-regulation, and the District Officer referred to in paragraph (b) of that sub-regulation in any other case, shall be the prescribed officer.
