*Arrest (Amendment) Act 2000,*

Being an Act to amend the *Arrest Act* (Chapter 339),

MADE by the National Parliament to come into operation in accordance with a notice in the National Gazette by the Head of State, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the Minister.

**1. COMPLIANCE WITH CONSTITUTIONAL REQUIREMENTS.**

This Act, to the extent that it regulates or restricts a right or freedom referred to in Subdivision III.3.C (*qualified rights*) of the *Constitution*, namely, the right to freedom of movement conferred by Section 52 of the *Constitution*, is a law that is made for the purpose of giving effect to the public interest in public safety and public order.

**2. APPLICATION (AMENDMENT OF SECTION 2).**

Section 2 of the Principal Act is amended:-

- (a) by inserting the following parentheses at number "(1)" before the word "Notwithstanding"; and
- (b) in Subsection (1), by repealing the words and figures "but subject to Section 24" and replacing them with the following:-

"but subject to Subsection (2) and to Section 24"; and

(c) by adding the following new subsection:-

“(2) This Act does not apply to an arrest made under the *Civil Aviation Act 2000*.”.
