Appropriation (Recurrent Expenditure) Act 1995,

Being an Act to grant and apply out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund a sum for the General Public Service for recurrent expenditure for the year ending 31 December 1996 and to appropriate the supplies granted for that year,

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MADE by the National Parliament.

1. GRANT OF K922,304,500.

Subject to authorization from the Minister, the Secretary for Finance may issue out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund and apply for the service of the General Public Service for the financial year ending 31 December 1996 the sum of K922,304,500.

2. APPROPRIATION.

Sums granted by this Act out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund for the services of the financial year ending 31 December 1996 are appropriated for the purposes and services expressed in the Schedule in relation to the financial year ending 31 December 1996.

3. ADJUSTMENT OF APPROPRIATION FOR NEW SERVICES AND AS BETWEEN SERVICES.

Where there is insufficient or no appropriation to meet expenditure for a particular service, the Minister may direct the allocation of additional appropriation through the Secretary's Advance, provided that the total additional appropriation so allocated does not exceed the aggregate of the net appropriation of K1,000,000 provided under Vote No: 207-4201-4-102-135.

4. ADJUSTMENT OF APPROPRIATION AS BETWEEN SERVICES.

(1) Subject to Subsection (2), where there is insufficient appropriation to meet recurrent expenditure the Minister may direct the re-allocation of any unexpended appropriation under recurrent expenditure to recurrent expenditure, provided that the total of re-allocation shall not exceed a sum of K140,000,000.

Appropriation (Recurrent Expenditure)

(2) Where the amounts of Special Appropriation, other than those relating to debt charges, are found to be understimated, savings equivalent to the amount stimated shall be made in the total amount made available under Section 1.

DIRECTION TO BE AVAILABLE TO AUDITOR-GENERAL.

A copy of each direction under Sections 3 and 4 shall be made available to the or-General as soon as practicable after the end of each quarter of the finanial year ag 31 December 1996.

TRANSFER OF ACTIVITIES BETWEEN DEPARTMENTS.

Where, after the commencement of this Act and before 1 January 1997, an activity ansferred from one operating agency to another, the authority conferred by Sections 1 2 to issue and apply moneys out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund extends to the e and application of moneys in respect of the carrying out of the activity by that other rating agency.
