- 1. REPEAL OF SECTION 1A.
 Section 1A of the Principal Act is repealed.
- 2. ADMINISTRATION OF THIS ACT (AMENDMENT OF SECTION 3). Section 3 of the Principal Act is amended
 - (a) by repealing Subsection (2) and replacing it with the following:-
 - "(2) There shall be a Commissioner of Customs who shall -
 - (a) be appointed by notice in the National Gazette by the National Executive Council after considering a recommendation from the Commissioner General; and
 - (b) be appointed for such period, of not less than five years or more than seven years, as the National Executive Council determines; and
 - (c) be eligible for re-appointment."; and
 - (b) by adding the following new Subsection:-
 - "(3) The office of Commissioner of Customs is hereby declared to be an office to and in relation to which Division III.2 (Leadership Code) of the Constitution applies."
