Being an Act to amend the *Printing of the Laws Act* (Chapter 333),

MADE by the National Parliament.

1. AMENDMENT OF LONG TITLE.

The long title to the Act is amended by adding the following:-

“and to their establishment in a database in electronic format.”

2. NEW SECTION 3A.

The Principal Act is amended by inserting after Section 3 the following new section:-

“3A. ESTABLISHMENT OF DATABASE IN ELECTRONIC FORMAT.

(1) The Minister may, by notice in the National Gazette, authorize a person to establish a database in electronic format of the laws of Papua New Guinea.

“(2) The database shall be under the control of the First Legislative Counsel.”


Printing of the Laws (Amendment)

3. **FIRST LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL MAY GIVE CERTAIN DIRECTIONS
(AMENDMENT OF SECTION 4).**

Section 4(1) of the Principal Act is amended by inserting after the words "print or reprint any law the following":-

"or an authorized person to include the laws in the database".
