Being an Act to amend the *Public Services (Management) Act* 2014, and for related purposes,

MADE by the National Parliament.

REPEAL AND REPLACEMENT OF SECTION 45.

Section 45 of the Principal Act, is repealed and replaced with the following:

"45. CITIZEN TECHNICAL ADVISERS.

- (1) This section applies to a citizen who is employed by an accredited aid agency to provide advisory support to the National Public Service (a citizen technical adviser).
- (2) The regulations may require that a citizen technical adviser enter into a performance and conduct agreement with the relevant Departmental Head.
- (3) Unless expressly provided for in his or her contract of employment with an accredited aid agency, a citizen technical adviser is not:
 - (a) an officer of the Public Service; or
 - (b) subject to -
 - (i) any other provisions of this Act; or
 - (ii) the General Orders of the Public Service; or
 - (iii) a code of conduct issued under Section 73(1).
 - (4) In this section, unless the contrary intention appears -
 - "accredited aid agency" means an aid agency, contractor or other entity authorised to employ a citizen technical adviser;
 - "advisory support" includes those activities of a citizen technical adviser that are intended to enhance the performance and capacity of the National Public Service.".
