Supplementary Appropriation (Priority Expenditure 2006) Act 2006,

Being an Act to grant and apply out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund an additional sum for Priority Expenditure for the year ending 31 December 2006 and to appropriate that sum,

MADE by the National Parliament.

1. GRANT OF K 682,500,000.00.

Subject to authorization from the Minister, the Secretary for Treasury may issue out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund and apply for Priority Expenditure for the year ending 31 December 2006 the sum of K 682,500,000.00.

2. APPROPRIATION.

Sums granted by this Act out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund for Priority Expenditure for the year ending 31 December 2006 are appropriated for the purpose and services expressed in the Schedule in relation to the financial year ending 31 December 2006.

3. ADJUSTMENT OF APPROPRIATION FOR NEW SERVICES AND AS BETWEEN SERVICES.

Where there is insufficient or no appropriation to meet expenditure for a particular service, the Secretary for Treasury may direct the re-allocation of any unexpended appropriation through the Secretary's Advance provided that the total additional Appropriation so allocated does not exceed the amount the amount reflected under the Secretary's Advance.

Supplementary Appropriation (Priority Expenditure 2006)

4. ADJUSTMENT OF APPROPRIATION AS BETWEEN SERVICES.

- (1) Where there is insufficient appropriation to meet priority expenditure, the Secretary for Treasury may redirect the allocation of any unexpended appropriation to priority expenditure, provided that the total of reallocation shall not exceed a sum of K682,500,000.00.
- (2) Funds shall not be transferred between programs, or between activities within programs, without the written approval of the Secretary for Treasury.

5. TRANSFER OF ACTIVITIES BETWEEN DEPARTMENTS.

Where after the commencement of this Act and before 1 January 2007, an activity is transferred from one operating agency to another, the authority conferred by Sections 3 and 4 to issue and apply moneys out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund extends to the issue and application of moneys in respect to carrying out activities by that other operating agency.

6. DIRECTION.

A copy of each direction under Sections 3 and 4 shall be made available to the Auditor-General as soon as practicable after the end of quarter of the financial year ending 31 December 2006.
