MADE by the Deputy Price Controller appointed under the *Prices Regulation Act* 1949, as amended to date, to come into operation on the date of publication in the *Government Gazette*.

1. DEFINITIONS.

In this Order—

- "safety matches" means safety matches manufactured in Papua New Guinea, namely "National" and "King" brands;
- "box" means a box containing an average of 50 matches;
- "retail" means for the purpose of consumption or use.

Prices Order No. 137—*continued***2. MAXIMUM RETAIL PRICE.**

Notwithstanding the provisions of Prices Orders No. 117 and No. 118, the maximum price at which safety matches may be sold at any of the locations specified in Schedule 1, is the amount specified in the second column of Schedule 2.

3. DISPLAY OF PRICES.

A person or organisation who has in his custody or under his control any safety matches to which this Order applies, for sale by retail, or who offers, exhibits or exposes any of those safety matches for sale by retail, shall display a ticket, label, placard or notice attached to or exhibited or displayed with those safety matches setting forth in a prominent position in clear and legible figures easily discernible to any person inspecting such safety matches, the price at which the safety matches concerned may be bought.

Prices Regulation Act 1949, as amended to date

MAXIMUM PRICES FOR PETROL, DISTILLATE AND LIGHTING KEROSENE

I, MILTON FREDERICK ROBERTS, a Deputy Price Controller, by virtue of the powers conferred by the *Prices Regulation Act 1949*, as amended to date, and all other powers me enabling, do hereby make the following Order under that Act:—

PRICES ORDER No. 138**1. CITATION.**

This Order may be cited as Prices Order No. 138.

2. COMMENCEMENT.

This Order shall come into operation on the date of publication of this Order in the *Gazette*.

3. REVOCATION.

The Prices Orders specified in Schedule 2 of this Order are revoked.

4. DEFINITIONS.

In this Order—

"petrol" includes any substance normally sold a petrol whether or not containing additives of any kind;

"distillate" includes any substance normally sold a automotive distillate whether or not containing additives of any kind;

"kerosene" includes any substance normally sold a kerosene, being a medium refined petroleum product as used for lighting and cooking in home appliances, whether or not containing additives of any kind;

"wholesaler" in relation to petrol, distillate or kerosene means a person or a firm who sells petrol, distillate or kerosene for the purpose of resale and not for the purpose of use;

"supplier" in relation to petrol, distillate or kerosene, means a person or a firm who sells petrol, distillate or kerosene for the purpose of use;

"retail" means for the purpose of consumption or use.

5. MAXIMUM PRICE.

(i) Subject to Subclause (ii) of this clause, where petrol, distillate or kerosene is supplied—

(a) at a locality specified in the first column of Schedule 1 to this Order; or

(b) at some other place to which the petrol, distillate or kerosene is transported from any such locality by or on behalf of a wholesaler or the supplier;

the maximum price per gallon at which the petrol, distillate or kerosene may be supplied is the sum of—

(c) the maximum retail selling price specified in the Second, Third or Fourth Column as the case may be, of Schedule 1 in relation to the locality concerned; and

(d) the amount (if any) charged for the transport referred to in paragraph (b) of this subclause.

Maximum Prices for Petrol, Distillate and Lighting Kerosene—*continued*

(ii) Where the maximum price of any quantity of petrol, distillate or kerosene supplied at any one time, calculated in accordance with Subclause (i) of this clause is an amount involving a fraction of a toea, the supplier may charge to the next whole toea.

6. SUPPLY TO GOVERNMENT ETC.

Nothing in this Order applies to or relates to the supply of petrol, distillate or kerosene to the Government, Australia or a Statutory Authority of the Government or Australia.

7. DISPLAY OF PRICES.

A person or an organisation engaged in selling petrol, distillate or lighting kerosene by retail shall display in each of the places of business in prominent positions and in large, clear and legible figures the maximum prices at which such petrol, distillate or lighting kerosene may be bought.
