Motor Vehicles (Third Party Insurance) Act 1974

1977

FIXING OF LEVEL OF PREMIUMS

I, Julius Chan, Minister for Finance, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 31 of the Motor Vehicles (Third Party Insurance) Act 1974 and all other powers me enabling, and having received a report from the Premium-Fixing Advisory Committee, hereby-

- (a) revoke the notice of Fixing of Level of Premiums dated 28th October, 1976 and published in National Gazette No. G89 of 4th November, 1976; and
- (b) fix as the level of premiums payable in respect of the issue of third-party insurance cover the amount specified in Column 3 of the Schedule for the class of vehicle specified in Column 1 and described in Column 2 opposite that class of vehicle and premium payable.

SCHEDULE

	(a) if used by the owner or by any other person for the carriage of the owner, his family, relatives, or friends for purposes of pleasure or for private or domestic purposes, but not directly for business purposes. A motor car shall not be deemed to be used for business purposes within the meaning of this paragraph merely by reason of the fact that it is used for the carriage of any person to and from his place of business or the place where he exercises his profession or calling; or	
	(b) if used personally by the owner, being an individual, for the purpose of making personal calls in relation to his profession, business or calling, provided that such profession, business or calling is not that of a commercial traveller, insurance agent or inspector or assessor, land or estate agent, manufacturer's agent, stock agent, station agent or salesman; or	
	 (c) if used by religious or social workers in the course of their religious or social work; or 	
	 (d) if used by medical practitioners for the purpose of their profession; or 	
	(e) if used by farmers in connexion with their farming opera- tions; or	
	(f) if used in connexion with the work of any public or private hospital or charitable institution, by or on account of the Board or other authority controlling such hospital or institu- tion or trade union; or
