Industrial Relations Act (Chapter 174)

ADJUSTMENT OF MINIMUM WAGES UNDER THE MINIMUM WAGES BOARD DETERMINATION No. 1 OF 1983

1. The Consumer Price Index (C.P.I.) as calculated by the National Statistical Office has shown a percentage increase in the index for the twelve (12) months ending December 1984 of 4.4(%) percent.
2. Clauses 5.1 and 5.2 of the Determination prescribes the manner for calculating the increase of wages for the National Minimum Wage for Level 1 and Level 2 Centres.
3. Clause 5.3 of the Determination prescribes the manner of calculating the increase of wages for the National Rural Minimum Wage.
4. Clause 5.132 of the Determination prescribes the date of effect of the increase in wages.
5. The National Minimum Wages payable with effect on and from 1st March, 1985 under the provisions of the Minimum Wages Board Determination No. 1 of 1983 are:

MINIMUM RATES OF PAY FOR CENTRES DESIGNATED AS LEVEL 1 AND LEVEL 2 AREAS EFFECTIVE AS FROM 1st MARCH, 1985 FOLLOWING THE CONSUMER PRICE INDEX INCREASE OF 4.4 (%) PERCENT, AND RETROSPECTIVE TO 1st JANUARY, 1985.
