TERMINATION OF APPOINTMENT AND APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS OF THE POST AND TELECOMMUNICATION CORPORATION BOARD

I, Kingsford Dibela, G.C.M.G., K.St.J., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Sections 7, 8, 9 and 11, of the *Post and Telecommunication Corporation Act 1982* and all other powers me enabling—

- (a) acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, hereby terminate the appointments of Douglas MacGowan as member and Deputy Chairman, Neil Prideaux as member and Graham Reynolds as alternate member (all of whom have resigned their offices); and
- (b) acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, given after consideration of recommendations by the Minister for Communications, hereby appoint—
 - (i) Douglas Matheson to be a member under Section 7(2)(e) and John Grindal to be his alternate member; and
 - (ii) Joseph Sindaeken to be a member under Section 7(2)(g); and
 - (iii) appoint Douglas Matheson to be the Deputy Chairman of the Board,

for a period of three years commencing on and from the date of publication of this instrument in the *National Gazette*.

DECLARATION OF NATIONAL EMERGENCY
