Organic Law on Certain Constitutional Office-holders

Land Settlement Schemes (Prevention of Disruption) Act (Chapter 358)

## **DECLARATION UNDER SECTION 2**

I, Kingsford Dibela, G.C.M.G., K.St.J., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 2 of the Land Settlement Schemes (Prevention of Disruption) Act (Chapter 358) and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, which, after consultation with the Minister for Lands as prescribed under Section 2(3) of the Act, is of the opinion that the nature of the scheme and the likely relationship between the leaseholders are such that disruptive conduct could endanger the success of the scheme or social relations between the leaseholders, hereby declare the areas of Government land specified in the Schedule over which State lease have been or are to be granted or made available for the purpose of the development of the land as, or as part of, a planned scheme of settlement or development, to be land in a declared scheme for the purposes of the Act.
