

Know you that I, John Momis, Deputy Prime Minister and Minister for Public Service, reposing confidence in your integrity and ability do, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 2 of the Commissions of Inquiry Act (Chapter 31) and all other powers me enabling, by this my Commission appoint you, the said Theodore Reginald Bredmeyer, Silas Samuel and Martin Loi to be Commissioners under that Act, and authorize you to inquire into and report on matters in which inquiry would be, in my opinion, for the public welfare, that is to say to inquire into the following matters:

- Whether the Government acted improperly in the appointment of agents in connection with the sale of the Government's Kumul aircraft.
- Whether there were any irregularities in the payment of commission in respect of the sale price of the Government's Kumul aircraft.
- Whether the Government appointed agents to act on its behalf in connection with the purchase of the Arava aircraft for the Defence Force.
- Whether any irregular payments, by way of commission or otherwise, were made by the Government, in connection with the purchase of the Arava aircraft for the Defence Force.
- Whether the Prime Minister, or any other Minister, obstructed, or attempted to obstruct, the search by Police and Customs officials of aircraft registered No. VH-JJA owned by Peldale Pty. Ltd., at Jacksons Airport on 6th March,

And I appoint you, the said Theodore Reginald Bredmeyer to be Chairman of the Commission, And I fix the quorum for meetings of the Commission as the Chairman and one other Commissioner,

And I further direct that the Inquiry shall be held at such place or places in Papua New Guinea, or with my prior approval, elsewhere as to you may appear necessary or expedient,

And I further direct that the Inquiry shall be held in public,

And I further direct that you shall commence the Inquiry without delay and proceed therein with all dispatch and nder to me your report on or before 31st December, 1985.

And I further direct that you shall render an interim report to me on or before 30th September, 1985.
