(e) After the word "tobacco" delete the figures and words "10% of sales value" and insert in their stead the following: "2% of sales value shall be charged by the manufacturer on all products sold to wholesalers or retailers within the National Capital District and 1% of sales value shall be charged by the wholesaler or retailer at the wholesale or retail levels"
