Prime Minister Act (Chapter 27)

APPOINTMENT OF ACTING PRIME MINISTER

I, Wiwa Korowi, G.C.M.G., K.St.J., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 143(1) of the Constitution and Section 3(2) of the *Prime Minister Act (Chapter 27)*, and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, hereby appoint John Nilkare, a Minister, to be the Acting Prime Minister for a period commencing on and from 30th January, 1994 up to and including 2nd February, 1994.

Defence Act (Chapter 74)

APPOINTMENT OF ACTING COMMANDER OF THE DEFENCE FORCE

(b) appoint Paul Songo as Secretary, Department of Health for period of four years; and

(c) promote and appoint—

- (i) Tau Peruka to be Secretary, Department of Personnel Management; and
- (ii) Chris Vihuri to be Secretary, Department of Commerce and Industries; and

*Customs Tariff Act 1990***EXEMPTION FROM IMPORT DUTY**

Conditions—

- (a) the goods shall be imported on a firm and specific order by the PNG Forest Authority;
- (b) the exemption will not apply to those goods which are locally produced or manufactured;
- (c) the goods will remain at all times the property of the PNG Forest Authority;
- (d) the goods shall not be sold, exchanged or otherwise traded within five years of their importation; and
- (e) the exemption will remain in force only until 31st December, 1994.
