Pure Food Act (Chapter 233)

AMENDMENT OF PURE FOOD STANDARDS

I, Peter Barter, Minister for Health, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 6 of the *Pure Food Act* (Chapter 233), and all other powers me enabling, hereby, with effect on and from 1st June, 1995, amend the Pure Food Standards (Chapter 233), (being the Standards dated 10th May, 1973 and notified in Papua New Guinea Government *National Gazette* No. G47 of 31st May, 1973)—

(a) in Section 2—

(i) in Subsection (1), by adding the following paragraph:—

"(d) in the case of a label on a packet of iodized salt shall indicate—

(i) the amount of potassium iodate contained in it in the following manner:—

"Iodized Salt contains.....mg/Kg of Potassium Iodate"; and

(ii) the month and year of packing."; and

(ii) in Subsection (6), by adding the following paragraph:—

"and in respect of iodized salt, the statement required under Subsection (1)(a) shall appear in bold face sans serif capital letters of not less than 4.3 mm depth."; and

(b) in Section 3, by adding the following new paragraph:—

"(e) packaging or containers for packing iodized salt shall be moisture proof and/or shall have a polyethylene lining to protect iodized salt from moisture."; and

(c) by repealing Section 145 and replacing it with the following:—

"145. Salt (Iodized Salt).

(1) Salt—

(a) is sodium chloride, free from dirt; and

(b) shall contain, on a water-free basis and—

(i) not more than 1% of sulphates; and

(ii) not more than 0.1% of matter insoluble in a hot decinormal solution of hydrochloric acid; and

(iii) not more, in total, of 0.5% of calcium and magnesium chlorides; and

(c) shall be iodized.

"(2) Salt, other than table salt, shall contain potassium iodate in proportion of not less than 50 parts per million (ppm) (mg/Kg) and the iodine content shall be not less than 30 parts per million (ppm) (mg/Kg).

"(3) Table salt is fine grained, refined, crystalline salt with the addition of harmless agents to secure free running, in a total amount not exceeding 2%, and—

(a) it shall contain, on a water-free basis, not more than 0.6% of sulphates; and

(b) the total amount of calcium and magnesium chlorides shall not exceed 0.25%; and—

(c) it shall contain potassium iodate in a proportion not less than 70 parts per million (ppm) (mg/Kg) and iodine content shall be not less than 40 parts per million.

Amendment of Pure Food Standards—continued

- "(4) For the purposes of Subsection (3)—
 - (a) sulphates shall be calculated as CaSO₄, calcium chloride as CaCl₂ and magnesium chloride as MgCl₂; and
 - (b) the permissible harmless agents to secure free running properties include—
 - (i) sterile diatomaceous earth, in a proportion not exceeding 1%, that has a screen analysis such that not more than 1% is retained on a 300-mesh Britain Standards Institute screen; and
 - (ii) calcium silicate, sodium alumino-silicate, magnesium carbonate, tricalcium phosphate and calcium hydroxyphosphate.
- "(5) There shall be written on the lable as attached to a package of "Salt" or "Table Salt" the words "Iodized" immediately before the words "Salt" or "Table Salt" in bold face sans serif capital letters of not less than 4.3 mm face depth, and at least equal in size to the letters comprising the words "Salt" or "Table Salt".
- "(6) Salt or Table Salt shall not be sold, offered for sale or exhibited for sale or distributed for sale or stored for sale except in a sealed package or sealed container."
