DECLARATION OF SEDENTARY ORGANISMS

I, Titus Philemon, Minister for Fisheries and Marine Resources, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 2 (3) of the Fisheries Act 1994 and all other powers me enabling, hereby—

- (a) revoke the previous notice of declaration of sedentary organisms dated 8th August, 1978, and published in the *National Gazette* No. G71 of 31st August, 1978; and
- (b) being satisfied that each marine organism specified in the Schedule forms part of the living natural resources of Papua New Guinea continental shelf and that it belongs to a sedentary species, hereby declare each of those organisms to be a sedentary organisms to which this Act applies.

NOTICE OF PROHIBITION OF USING SHIPS FOR SEARCHING FOR OR TAKING SEDENTARY ORGANISMS

I, Titus Philemon, Minister for Fisheries and Marine Resources, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 52 (3) of the *Fisheries Act* 1994 and all other powers me enabling, and upon recommendation of the Authority, hereby prohibit the use of ships for searching for or taking sedentary organisms as declared under Section 2 unless authorised by a licence under Section 43.

Coffee Industry (Statutory Powers and Functions) Act 1991

MINIMUM QUALITY STANDARDS

THE Coffee Industry Corporation Limited, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 6(1)(c) of the Coffee Industry (Statutory Powers and Functions) Act 1991, and all other powers it enabling, hereby prohibits the purchase or sale of coffee cherries and coffee parchment except where the coffee cherries and coffee parchment comply with the minimum quality standards in the schedule.
