Customs Tariff Act 1990

#### **EXEMPTION OF IMPORT DUTY**

I, Silas Atopare, Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 9(1)(a) of the *Customs Tariff Act* 1990, and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, hereby exempt from import duty the goods specified in the Schedule imported to the East New Britain and North Solomons Provinces subject to such conditions as are specified in the Schedule with effect on and from the date of publication of this instrument in the *National Gazette*.

#### SCHEDULE

- 1. Machinery and mechanical appliances, electrical equipment, parts thereof, sound recorders and reproducers, television image and sound recorders and reproducers, and parts and accessories of such articles;
- 2. Cocoa processing machine and parts thereof;
- 3. Coconut processing machine and parts thereof:
- 4. Palm oil processing machine and parts thereof:
- 5. Chicken processing and hatching machineries and parts thereof;
- 6. Shell button processing machine and parts thereof;
- 7. Machineries of any type whether electrically operated or mechanically hand operated;
- 8. Quarrying extracted machine and parts thereof;
- 9. Vehicles, aircraft, vessels and associated transport equipment;
- 10. Base metals and articles of base metal;
- Natural or cultured pearls, precious or semi-precious stones, precious metals clad with precious metal and articles thereof, imitation jewellery, coin;
- 12. Articles of stone, plaster, cement, asbestos, mica or similar materials, ceramic products, glass and glassware;
- 13. Footwear, headgear, umbrellas, sun umbrellas, walking-sticks, seat-sticks, whips, riding-crops and parts thereof, prepared feathers and articles made therewith, artificial flowers, articles of human hair;
- 14. Textiles and textile articles;

- 15. Pulp of wood or of other dibrous cellulosic material, recovered (waste and scrap) paper or paperboard, paper and paperboard and articles thereof;
- 16. Wood and articles of wood, wood charcoal, cork and articles of cork, manufactures of straw or esparto or of other plaiting materials, basketware and wickerwork;
- 17. Products of the chemical or allied industries;

18. Mineral projects;

- 19. Prepared foodstuffs, beverages, spirits and vinegar, tobacco and manufactured tobacco substitutes;
- 20. Animal or vegetable fats and oils and their cleavage products, prepared edible fats, animal or vegetable waxes;
- 21. Vegetable products;
- 22. Live animals, animal product; and
- 23. Volcanic machineries, equipment and parts thereof.
