 - (v) PFIL shall not be exposed to any forms of debts (loans, securities equity investments, etc.,) or off-balance sheet transactions (guarantees, foreign transactions, letter of credit, etc.) by more than 25.0 per cent of its shareholders' funds to related parties of the company and their affiliates who have direct or indirect shareholding exceeding 20.0 per cent of the voting share capital of PFIL.
