Customs Tariff Act 1990

EXEMPTION FROM IMPORT DUTY

I, Wiwa Korowi, G.C.M.G., K.St.J., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 9(1)(a) of the Customs Tariff Act 1990 and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, hereby exempt from payment of import duty with effect from 1st September, 1997 to and ending on 18th September, 1997 the goods mentioned in the Schedule subject to such conditions as are specified in the Schedule.

SCHEDULE

Motor Vehicles imported between 1st September, 1997 and 18th September, 1997 by any person under an arrangement with the Government of Papua New Guinea and approved by the Commissioner-General for the purpose of on-lending on a gratuitous basis by the owners to and for the use by participants at the Hiri Moale Festival and Independence Celebrations in September, 1997 on condition that the motor vehicles shall upon the conclusion of the Hiri Moale Festival and Independence Celebrations be sold to Government Agencies at a price fully reflecting the reduction in import duty.

Should any motor vehicle subject to duty exemption herein be sold, exchanged, traded or otherwise disposed of before 12th September, 1997, the owner shall be liable for and import duty shall be payable at the date of such disposal on the CIF value of the motor vehicle at the date of original importation.
