#### PROCLAMATION OF CURFEW

I, Silas Atopare, G.C.M.G., K.St.J., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 3 of the *Curfew Act* 1987 and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, hereby require every person with the boundaries of the National Capital District (being the area specified in the *Organic Law on the Boundaries of the National Capital District*) to remain within doors between the hours of seven o'clock in the evening (7.00 p.m.) and five o'clock in the morning (5.00 a.m.) for a period commencing on and from seven o'clock in the evening (7.00 p.m.) on Tuesday 26th June, 2001 until five o'clock in the morning (5.00 a.m.) on Tuesday, 10th July, 2001.

## REVOCATION OF APPOINTMENT AND APPOINTMENT OF PROVINCIAL ADMINISTRATOR OF THE SOUTHERN HIGHLANDS PROVINCE

THE NATIONAL EXECUTIVE COUNCIL, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 73 of the Organic Law on Provincial Governments and Local-Level Government and all other powers it enabling, after—

- (a) considering a list comprising the names of three persons submitted by the Minister for Provincial and Local Government Affairs (the powers of the Southern Highlands Provincial Government having been withdrawn); and
- (b) consultation with the Public Services Commission,

hereby—

- (c) revokes the appointment of Pila Niningi; and
- (d) appoints Uhae labo for a period of three years,

as Provincial Administrator of the Southern Highlands Province with effect on and from the date of publication of this instrument in the *National Gazette*.
