### APPOINTMENT OF TRIBUNAL UNDER SECTION 5(1) AND (2) OF THE JUDICIAL CONDUCT ACT 2012

I, Sir Michael Ogio, G.C.M.G., K.St.J., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 5(2) of the *Judicial Conduct Act* 2012 and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the Parliament and on the receipt of the notification from the Speaker of the National Parliament of the referral of Chief Justice Sir Salamo Injia hereby:—

- (a) appoint a Tribunal under Section 5(2) and (3) of the Judicial Conduct Act 2012 to inquire into alleged breach of Section 5(1) of the Judicial Conduct Act 2012 by Chief Justice Sir Salamo Injia; and
- (b) appoint:-
  - (i) Paul Akuram (a former judge of the National Court) as Chairman of the Tribunal; and
  - (ii) John Brown and Maurice Sheehan (a former judge of the National Court) as members of the Tribunal; and
- (c) refer the matter of alleged breach of Section 5(1) of the Judicial Conduct Act 2012 by Chief Justice Sir Salamo Injia to the Tribunal for its inquiry and report back to Parliament.
