CONSTITUTION

DETERMINATION OF MINISTERIAL RESPONSIBILITIES

I, PETER O'NEILL, Prime Minister, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 148 of the Constitution and all other powers me enabling, hereby determine that each Minister specified in Column 1 of the Schedule hereto shall have the responsibilities of the Ministries as shown opposite his name in Column 2, and for the administration of the relevant legislation.

Don Polye	Minister for Treasury and Finance, Correctional Services, Labour Labour and Industrial Relations and Immigration and Transport.
Patrick Pruaitch	Minister for Housing and Urban Development, Provincial and Local-level Government and Forest.
William Duma	Minister for Petroleum and Energy, Defence, Tourism, Art and Culture and Autonomy and Autonomous Regions.
Puka Temu	Minister for Public Service, Agriculture and Livestock and Foreign Affairs and Trade.
James Marape	Minister for Higher Education, Research, Science and Technology, Education, Works and Implementation and Lands and Physical Planning.
Charles Abel	Minister for Commerce, Industry, SME and Informal Sector, Justice and Attorney General, and Communication and Information Technology.
