DETERMINATION OF PETITION FOR EXEMPTION FROM REQUIREMENT IN CIVIL AVIATION OPERATING RULE 121.69(h)

I, Wilson Sagati, Acting Director of Civil Aviation, under Section 79(1) of the *Civil Aviation Act 2000*, hereby grant Air Niugini Limited, being the holder of Air Operator Certificate No. 119/010 under Civil Aviation Rule Part 119, an exemption from the requirement of Civil Aviation Rule Part 121.69(h) and permitting Boeing 737-700/800 aircraft to operate onto aerodromes with 30m wide runways at Nadzab (Lae), Gurney (Alotau), Tokua (Rabaul), Momote and Wewak.

The granting of the exemption to Air Niugini is supported by the Manufacturers (Boeing) Revision to the Airplane Flight Manual (AFM) giving guidance to pilots operating the B737-700/800 and providing procedures, operational data and limitations associated with the operation of the aircraft and is intended to supplement the Aircraft Flight Manual for operations on runways with a width of 30m. The exemption is also granted in recognition of operational experience on 30m wide runways, conditions and limitations applied by recognised National Aviation Regulatory Authorities in the region.

This exemption shall come into effect from 15th August, 2012 until withdrawn in writing by the Director.
