APPOINTMENT AS AGENT

I, Jacob N.K. Popuna, LLB LM, Public Curator and Official Trustee of the Independent State of Papua New Guinea by virtue of the powers vested in/upon me pursuant to Section 4 of *Public Curators Act*, and all other powers enabling me hereby appoint Geoffrey K. Ambia, Chairman of Waripa Domesau Investment Ltd and Chairman of Waripa Land Group Incorporated (INC). Of P.O. Box 621, Mt Hagen WHP; to be the Agent of the Public Curator to investigate, compile a report, deal with appropriate Government Departments, State Corporations/Agents, Banks, private entities, Law Firms and all other persons that may assist to recover the Domisau and Waripa TRP Agreements and Treasury Investment Trusts established by the Government of Australia during the colonial administration on the 9th of November 1967 and 18th December 1967 respectively and the investors have since died, presumably intestate.

And furthermore by virtue of the powers vested in and upon me pursuant to Section 4 of the *Public Curator Act* (Chapter No. 81), and all other powers enabling me and including Section 36 of the *Interpretation Act* 1975 hereby appoint Geoffrey K. Ambia of the above address to take control, investigate, manage and administer the two (2) Kompiam, Enga Province (formerly Western Highlands Province - Jimi Timber Rights Purchase Agreements), one Land Trust Investment and all matters relating to the Deceased Estates on the following conditions and limitations pursuant to Section 4(2)(c) of the *Public Curator Act* (Chapter No. 81);

1. Domesau TRP, subject to production of authenticated evidence of authorization from the Late Ambia Pakau and/or the Domesau TRP Beneficiaries; and
2. Waripa TRP, subject to production of authenticated evidence of authorization Ambia Pakau and/or the Waripa TRP Beneficiaries; and
3. Lai land Trust Investment for the Beneficiaries.

Furthermore, the Agent shall carry out and perform all things for and on behalf of the Public Curator and Official Trustee to ascertain the facts surrounding the above named two Kompiam District, Enga Province TRPs and one land trust investment, the treasury investment held by the State, redemption of these treasury investments and distribution of the redeemed funds, less fees charges, expenses and to take possession of all monies, accounts, documents, records and other possessions relating to the estate/trust held by any Government Agencies, corporations and private enterprises and individuals in Papua New Guinea or

elsewhere and to deliver such properties, monies and assets to the Public Curator and Official Trustee in coherence with instructions given from time to time by the Public Curator.

In Consideration Whereof the Agent shall be paid an amount not exceeding ten percent (10%) of the value of the assets/monies realized by the Agent on behalf of the Public Curator and Official Trustee and is further entitled to full reimbursement of costs such as professional consultancy fee, travel related expenses and other business expenses relating to this appointment, and where any expenses have been incurred by the Agent in accordance with the powers of this appointment or have been directed by the Public Curator to perform any other tasks consistent with this agency appointment, the Agent shall be entitled to full refund to such expenses from the above name two (2) TRPs Redeemed Funds and Lai Land Trust Investment redeemed funds.

This appointment is a private trust/estate appointment and is not binding on the Independence State of Papua New Guinea.
