AMENDMENT OF DETERMINATION OF TITLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF MINISTERS

I, Peter O'Neill, Prime Minister, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 148 of the Constitution and all other powers me enabling, hereby amend the Determination of Titles and Responsibilities of Ministers dated 10th August, 2012 and published in *National Gazette* No. G304 of 10th August, 2012 (as amended) —

- (a) in Schedule 3 (Minister for Treasury), Column 1, be deleting Peter O'Neill and inserting Patrick Pruaitch; and
- (b) in Schedule 5 (Minister for Forest and Climate Change), Column 1, by deleting Patrick Pruaitch and inserting Douglas Tomuriesa; and
- (c) in Schedule 22 (Minister for Labour and Industrial Relations), Column 1, by deleting Leo Dion and inserting Benjamin Poponawa.
