



AN ACT to appropriate one million seven hundred and seventy-five thousand and nine hundred and fifty-seven dollars to the service of the year ending the 31st December 1981.

ENACTED by the National Parliament of Solomon Islands.

- 1. This Act may be cited as the 1981 Supplementary Appropriation (No 2) Act 1981.
- 2. The issue from the Consolidated Fund is hereby authorised of a sum of one million seven hundred and seventy-five thousand and nine hundred and fifty-seven dollars to be applied to the service of the year ending 31st December 1981.
- 3. The sum specified in the preceding section shall be appropriated for the supply of the heads specified, and in the amounts respectively specified in relation thereto, in the Schedule.
