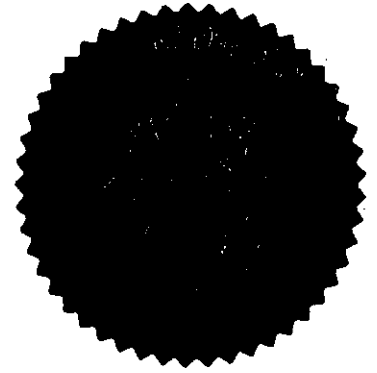

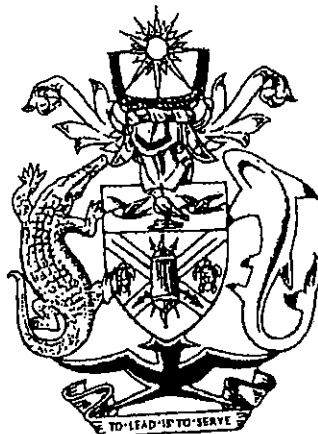

**CONSTITUTION (AMENDMENT) (NO.2)
ACT 2009**

Short title and commencement (No.2) Act 2009, and commences on the date it is published in the *Gazette*.

Section 54 amended

2. Section 54 of the Constitution is amended –

- (a) in subsection (1), by deleting “thirty” and “fifty” and substituting “fifty” and “seventy”, respectively; and
- (b) by repealing subsection (2) and substituting the following subsection –

“(2) The Constituency Boundaries Commission shall –

- (a) not later than ten years after the last review, review the number and boundaries of the constituencies whenever it considers such review to be desirable; and
 - (b) make recommendations to Parliament for alterations in the number and boundaries of the constituencies.”.
