THE CUSTOMS AND EXCISE ACT
(CAP. 58)THE CUSTOMS AND EXCISE (DUTIES) (AMENDMENT)
(NO. 4) ORDER 1996

IN exercise of the powers conferred by section 7 of the Customs and Excise Act, I, C.C.ABE, Minister of Finance, do hereby make the following Order: -

1. This order may be cited as the Customs and Excise (Duties) (Amendment) (No. 4) Order 1996 and shall come into force on the date of publication in the Gazette.
2. The rates of duty on goods specified under the subheadings 1604.1520 and 1604.1590 which originate and are imported from Papua New Guinea and Vanuatu, under the MSG TRADE Agreement shall not attract any import duty.
3. The reduced rate of duty to zero percent in respect of the items specified in paragraph 2 shall not apply to MSG items that originate from non-MSG countries. The rate of duty in respect of such items imported from non MSG Countries shall continue to attract the current rate of duty.
