(No. 5 of 1984)

SCHEDULE I (AMENDMENT) ORDER 1989

IN exercise of the powers conferred by section 3 of the Commodities Export Marketing Authority Act, and on the recommendation of the Authority, I, AUGUSTINE ROSE, Minister of Trade, Commerce and Industry hereby make the following Order -

1. This Order may be cited as the Schedule I (Amendment) Order 1989.
2. Schedule I to the Commodities Export Marketing Authority Act is hereby deleted and substituted therefore the following new Schedule I -

"SCHEDULE I

(SECTION 2)

Products and their Description

Coconut and coconut products	The fruit of the palm tree (<i>Cocos Nucifera</i>) and any product of that fruit whether in green or dried form.
Copra	The kernel or meat of the coconut (fruit of the palm tree) (<i>Cocos Nucifera</i>) when it has been extracted from the nut and dried.
Cocoa pods.	The fruit of the cocoa tree (<i>Theobroma Cacao Linnaeus</i>).
Unfermented cocoa beans	Seeds from the fruit of the cocoa tree (<i>Theobroma Cacao Linnaeus</i>) which have not been subjected to a fermentation and drying process..
Fermented cocoa beans and products	Seeds from the fruit of the cocoa tree (<i>Theobroma Cacao Linnaeus</i>) which have been subjected to a fermentation and drying process.
Palm Oil	Oil extracted from the fruit of the oil palm tree (<i>Elaeis Guineensis</i>).
Palm Kernel	Dried kernel or meat extracted or separated from the fruit of the oil palm tree (<i>Elaeis Guineensis</i>).
Palm based products.	Extracts or distillations from the fruit of the oil palm, (<i>Elaeis Guineensis</i>).
Spices	Any auromatic or pungent substance of vegetable origin commonly used to flavour food or as condiments and includes ginger, chillies, tumeric, cardmon or distillation of any such substance.

Coffee

The fruit of the shrubs (*Coffea arabica* and *canephora*), Arabica and Robusta varieties, or derivatives and any products of the fruit whether green or dried form."
