"SCHEDULE Products and their Description

Coconut and coconut products.	The fruit of the palm tree (<i>Cocos nucifera</i>) and any product of that fruit whether in green or dried form.
Copra.	The kernel or meat of the coconut (fruit of the palm tree) (Cocos nucifera) when it has been extracted from the nut and dried.
Cocoa pods.	The fruit of the cocoa tree (Theobroma Cacao Linnaeus).
Unfermented cocoa beans.	Seeds from the fruit of the cocoa tree (<i>Theobroma Cacao Linnaeus</i>) which have not been subjected to a fermentation and drying process.
Fermented cocoa beans and products.	Seeds from the fruit of the cocoa tree (<i>Theobroma Cacao Linnaeus</i>) which have been subjected to a fermentation and drying process.
Palm oil.	Oil extracted from the fruit of the oil palm tree (Elaeis guineensis).
Palm based products.	Extracts or distillations from the fruit of the oil palm, (Elaeis guineensis).
Spices.	Any aromatic or pungent substance of vegetable origin commonly used to flavour food or as condiments and includes ginger, chillies, tumeric, cardamon or distillation of any such substance.
Coffee.	The fruit of the shrubs (Coffea arabica and canephora), Arabica and Robusta varieties, or derivatives and any products of the fruit whether green or dried form.

Ngalinut. Dried ngalinut-in-shell, dried kernel separated from the shell of the fruit, the shell or resins from the ngalinut tree (Canarium spp.) including but not restricted to the following species, C.indicum, C. salomonense, C.harveyi (Var.nova-hebridiense)."
