IN exercise of the powers conferred by section 3 of the Constitutional Offices (Terms and Conditions of Service) Act, the Minister hereby makes the following regulations -

Citation 1.

These Regulations may be cited as the Constitutional Offices (Terms and Conditions of Service) (Ombudsman) (Amendment) Regulations and shall be deemed to have come into force on 1st January, 2006.
